

Brunch for a Bunch Recipe Contest

Prizes:

1st, 2nd and 3rd: Gifts baskets from the VA Egg Council
Top three winners are eligible to compete at the State Fair of Virginia

Prizes at State Finals

- 1st - \$375 plus a year's supply of Egglard's Best Eggs**
- 2nd - \$250 plus 6 month's supply of Egglard's Best Eggs**
- 3rd - \$125 plus 6 month's supply of Egglard's Best Eggs**

Rules:

- Open to any individual who is a Virginia resident; one entry per person. Participant does not have to reside in county where fair is held. Local fairs are asked to waive any residency requirements. Participants are eligible to participate in ONE contest one time.
- Entrant must prepare any type of brunch item that will serve a collection of people. Ex.: Savory cheesecake; Deviled eggs; Brunch casserole; Quiche; Frittata.
- **A minimum of 6 large eggs must be used in the entered recipe.**
- For cost savings, a recipe making a large quantity may be broken down to fit into a 9x9" container and that submitted for competition along with the written recipe for the larger amount. (Some brunch casseroles feeding 10-12, bake in 9x13 pans).
- Entry should be presented in a disposable container for judging.
- Recipe must list ingredients in order of use; preparation instructions; pan size (and type); and cooking time and temperatures, must be included. Written recipe must be printed on one side of page and must be submitted with prepared entry. Back side of page must include contestant's name, address, phone and email address.

Notes

- Your fair accepts any liability if brunch items are served to the public.
- Fairs are in charge of safe food handling procedures (accept items that should be kept cold from coolers, and judge hot items promptly or keep cold and reheat samples to appropriate tasting temperature.
- A sample judging form is enclosed. Modifications may be made.
- Fairs will determine whether or not to share judges' forms with participants.
- This is an adult competition – Contestants under age 18 will be judged as adults.
- Recipes will become the property of the Virginia Egg Council.
- *If it is impossible to offer heating (or cooling) for judged items, the local fair may judge on written recipes only or conduct 'visual' judging.*

Winners' Info and recipes must be submitted to the VA Egg Council (on *Winners Information Form*). The VA Egg Council will forward this to the State Fair of VA who will contact winners at the beginning of September with final competition information. *All competing recipes should be sent as well.*

Judging will be based on:

Flavor	Creativity
Texture	Appearance
Appropriateness of Ingredients for recipe	Recipe requirements filled
